



MyQAN is the acronym for Malaysian Higher Education Institutions Quality Assurance Network, where:

- My is the abbreviation for Malaysian;
- QAN is abbreviation for Quality Assurance Network;
- The colour of the text is word in blue colour which is to symbolise quality, as blue is a typical colour for quality;
- The different font used for letter “Q”, which is also in italic style, represents the dynamism and importance of quality and its tail to encompass the letter “A” indicates quality assurance as the main theme of the Network.
- The elliptical cyclone-like object to indicate the PDCA quality cycle, where:
  - The cycle represents the continual quality improvement cycle that is dynamic and continually in evolution;
  - All four phases in the cycle is in different colours and each respectively implies:
    - Plan (in blue);
    - Do (in red);
    - Check (in yellow);
    - Act (in green).
  - The graphic object representing each phase contains two part:
    - The nose or leading edge of the object symbolises quality checkpoint or milestone;
    - The tail or trailing edge of the object indicates quality activities or efforts required to reach each milestone.
    - The rotational direction is clockwise as in a typical quality cycle.
